Day 1- Welcome to Provence

Naomi and Franck will meet you in person at the TGV station in Avignon where you will be transported to your home for the week. After settling in your room, you are invited to join your travel companions for drinks around the pool, discuss the week ahead and enjoy a light meal of local cheese, charcuterie with an assortment of local wines.

Day 2- Isle-sur-la-Sorgue

This morning you will wake up to your new, slower pace of life. We will head to l'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue, also known as the "Provençal Venice", thanks to the abundance of waterways. On Sundays, the town turns into an antiques market surrounded by restaurants, cafes and streets teeming with people, colour and scents! In the evening, we will head back home for aperitif and will have dinner at one of the most picturesque restaurants around.

Day 3- The world around the Olive

This is no regular rushed Monday with breakfast around the pool. It's time to get into our van and head to a world renowned olive mill and meet Magali – the first woman "olive oil sommelier" - who will explain how to make olive oil and invite us for a unique tasting in her wonderful and peaceful facility. For lunch, Magali will prepare a few traditional dishes right in front of us and we will all sit down at the table in the farm courtyard. Back at home for drinks before supper just behind our back door.

Day 4- Marché de Provence

After a relaxing morning, today's experience takes us to market day in Gordes. A market in Provence should be on everybody's bucket list and all your senses will be stimulated by the scents, the colour and the livelihood around the stalls. After lunch, we will browse through the mysterious Village des Bories. This open-air museum of 20 or so stone huts will transport you to another time. On the way home, we will enjoy a casual aperitif and evening meal in the village of Beaumettes.

Day 5- Wine and Chocolate

Today will tickle your sweet tooth (assuming you have one!). A treat! After your poolside breakfast we will head to Chateauneuf-du-Pape, home of one of the most famous French wines to taste this unique assemblage of up to 13 grape varieties. First, we will attend a chocolate making workshop and you will have the opportunity to pair chocolate with local wines. What a unique and decadent experience! Right after, our proposed winery tour includes tasting and a picnic vigneron. For supper, we will enjoy a very picturesque restaurant in Roussillon.

Day 6- Red cliffs and sunsets

Late morning, the group will leave for Roussillon and the "Sentier des Ochre". Two circular trails, taking 30 and 50 minutes to complete, twist through mini-desert landscapes with red cliffs. Ochre is a natural earth pigment which ranges in colour from yellow to deep orange or brown. After lunch in Roussillon, we will head to Ménerbes for a stroll in the village and supper in a wonderful open air restaurant with fantastic views as the sun sets.

Day 7- A chic Picnic, a corkscrew for every occasion, and a farewell to remember

This morning's coffee will be bitter sweet as we are starting our last group day together. For our final day in the region, we will travel to a special winery for a visit of the cellar and its highly unique museum collection. A charming picnic lunch prepared by the winery will be provided. Finally, we will meander home for aperitif and a sumptuous BBQ by the pool.

Day 8- Farewell Provence-à la prochaine.

Leaving Provence by mid-morning, Naomi and Franck will personally escort you back to the TVG station in Avignon to make your connections on to your next experience.
